## Change #1

1.7.7 Letters, Numerals or Words Intended to be Read More than Once

Insert a comma after "Numerals"

Proposed text

If <u>one or more letters, numerals or words</u> a letter or word appears only once but the design of the source of information makes it clear that <u>they are</u> it is intended to be read more than once, repeat the letters, <u>numerals</u> or words.

We suggest the following slightly simpler version.

"If <u>any</u> letter, <u>numeral</u>, or word appears only once, but the design of the source of information makes it clear that it is intended to be read more than once, repeat the letter, <u>numeral</u>, or word."
