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
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appellation of RDA entity

Definition and Scope

A nomen that is used within a given scheme or context to refer to an RDA entity.

Recording the nomen string

Recording an unstructured description

Record an unstructured description as RDA Entity: [name of RDA entity](#).

Can be name or title – in direct order, as it appears in source of information.

Recording a structured description

Record a structured description as RDA Entity: [access point for RDA entity](#).

Can be taken from a vocabulary encoding scheme or constructed using a string encoding scheme.

Recording an identifier

Record an identifier as RDA Entity: [identifier for RDA entity](#).

Structured description – access points

Access point for ...	Authorized access point	Variant access point
<p>Select from VES or construct using string encoding scheme.</p> <p>Include a value <i><u>based on</u></i> name or title of entity.</p> <p>Changes or omissions to name or title of entity.</p> <p>Include additional elements or designations.</p>	<p>Filter for preferred name or title of entity.</p> <p>Change or omission of name or title (e.g., inverted forms for name of person) selected for authorized access point.</p> <p>Elements to include (including other access points – creator of work; higher corporate body; whole work for parts).</p>	<p>Other access points not chosen as authorized.</p> <p>Variant name or title (can use preferred name or title in cases).</p> <p>Variants for different changes or omissions to name or title.</p> <p>Variants for additional elements (including other access points).</p>

Single work by one agent

CONDITION

A work is a single work that is created by one agent.

OPTION

Include:

a value of Agent:

a value that is based on Work:

[preferred title of work](#)

Additional elements – cases for Authorized access point for work

- Additional elements for creator of work 
 - Single work by one agent 
 - Collaborative work 
 - Compilation of works 
 - Compilation of works by one agent 
 - Compilation of complete works by one agent 
 - Compilation of complete works in a single form by one agent 
 - Incomplete compilation of works by one agent 
 - Compilation of works by more than one agent 
 - Commentary, annotations, illustrative content, etc. added to a previously existing work 
 - Work created by a person with different identities 
 - Work of uncertain or unknown origin 
- Additional elements for a manuscript with no title 
- Additional elements for a part or parts of a work 
 - One part of a work 
 - Two or more parts of a work 

Order of parts of name – Authorized access point for person

- Names that contain a surname
 - General guidelines on recording names that contain a surname
 - Names that include a term of honour or a term of address
 - Surname represented by an initial
 - Part of the name treated as a surname
 - Person known by a surname only
 - Married person identified only by a partner's name
 - Words, etc., indicating relationship following surnames
 - Saints
 - Compound surnames
 - Established usage
 - Established usage not determined
 - Surnames with separately written prefixes
 - Articles and prepositions
 - Other prefixes
 - Prefixes hyphenated or combined with surnames
 - Surnames of former members of royal houses

Examples of the “changes and omissions” instructions for a name or title used in an authorized access point.

Additional elements – Access point for person

- Additional elements and designations →
 - Undifferentiated names →
 - Additional elements or designations even if not needed to distinguish access points →
 - Additional elements or designations if needed to distinguish access points →
 - Additional elements or designations that assist in identification →

Additional elements – Access point for place

- Additional elements and designations →
 - Punctuation for additional elements →
 - Places in a state, province, territory, etc. of Australia, Canada, the United States, the former U.S.S.R., or the former Yugoslavia →
 - Places in England, Northern Ireland, Scotland, and Wales →
 - Places in overseas territories, dependencies, etc. →
 - Places in other jurisdictions →
