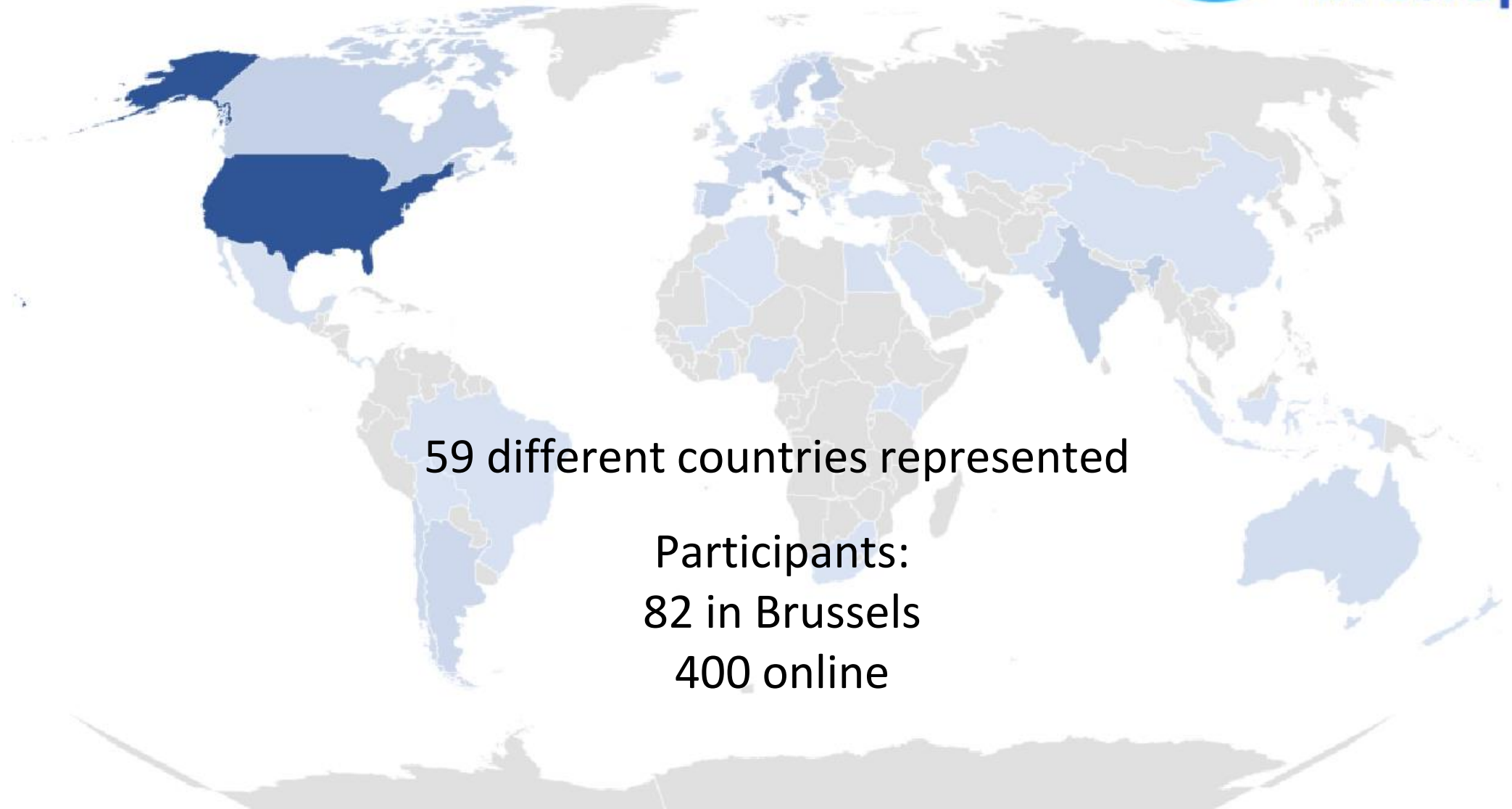
What is the BFWWE?
