Subject: Proposal on Dual-language naming of Corporate Body and Place

The text below sets out decisions taken by the RSC in their meeting in November 2024.

<u>RSC/ORDAC/2024/1</u> was published on 4 March for discussion at the April 2024 RSC Meeting. Following the <u>written responses</u> from the voting members of the RSC. <u>RSC/ORDAC/2024/1/summary</u> was prepared. ORDAC followed this with a response (<u>RSC/ORDAC/2024/summary/ORDAC</u>).

Following extensive discussion at the April 2024 RSC Meeting (<u>RSC/Minutes/456-468</u> Item 462), it was decided that further discussion of this topic was needed. A subgroup consisting of the RSC Chair, Regional Representatives, Wider Community Engagement Officer and Translations Team Liaison Officer was delegated to meet and determine next steps. The Examples Editor added examples based on those in RSC/ORDAC/2024/1 to the Toolkit for the July Release (<u>RSC/Minutes/469-482</u> Item 470.2.1).

<u>RSC/ORDAC/2024/1/rev</u> was published on 29 August for discussion at the November 2024 RSC Meeting and voting members of the RSC approved it in a unanimous vote (<u>RSC/Minutes/483-499</u> Item 483). In response to the suggestions made by NARDAC and summarised in the Notes of the summary document (<u>RSC/ORDAC/2024/1/rev/summary</u>), Oceania Representative Charlotte Christensen said on behalf of ORDAC that she was happy to

leave the wording and location to the admin team. Some of the wording in this decisions

document is, therefore, derived from NARDAC's suggested wording

(RSC/ORDAC/2024/1/rev/summary).
